## Spring 2 Online Bullying

Every half term, each teacher delivers an online safety lesson to your child. This half term the lessons have focused on 'Online Bullying'. This strand teaches your child appropriate ways to behave online and offers strategies for effective reporting and intervention.

1. Encourage your child to always respect others. Tell them to be careful what they say online and what images they send.

2. Remind your child that whatever they send can be made public very quickly and could stay online forever.

3. Keep passwords safe.

4. Spend time with your child learning about the games and apps they use. Find out how to block or report someone that is being unkind.

6. Make sure your child does not retaliate or reply to inappropriate online behaviour.
